## READ

*Family worship:* Proverbs 16:1-17

*Private worship:* Numbers 35-36, Joel 2:28-3:21, Psalm 149, 1 Timothy 6:3-21

*Discussion questions:* Is it better to earn a little bit of wealth honestly or a lot of wealth dishonestly? What do these passages say about God? What do these passages say about me? What do these passages say about the relationship between God and me?

## PRAY

*Adoration:* God is holy, mighty, gracious, and merciful. Spend time declaring your love for Him.

*Confession:* Continually confessing your sins to God and asking for His forgiveness will keep you from taking the great price Christ paid on the cross for granted.

*Thanksgiving:* Express your thankfulness to God for the blessings He has given you. When we consider that we deserve punishment because of our sinfulness, and instead God gives to us His love and mercy, our only response should be one of thankfulness.

*Supplication:* Pray for specific opportunities to share the message of Christ with others. Pray for boldness and pray that God would give you the wisdom to be able to reach into the lives of those around you.

Ask God to show you how to respond to the needs of others.

### Catechism:
